Joshua 24:19-20

If you say it but don't mean it, you'll be worse off than if you don't say it...



Joshua 24:21

The people considered Joshua's warning and then restated, "We will serve the Lord."

Joshua 24:22

Joshua makes them accountable to each other. They affirm "we are witnesses"



Joshua 24:23

Joshua restates, "put away the foreign 'gods' and give your hearts to the Living God"

'We will serve the Lord and obey His voice!"

Joshua affirmed their commitment and places a large stone as a memorial

Events at Shechem: Abraham's 1st place of worship Jacob buried foreign "gods" here Jesus met the woman at the well Joshua placed memorial here
