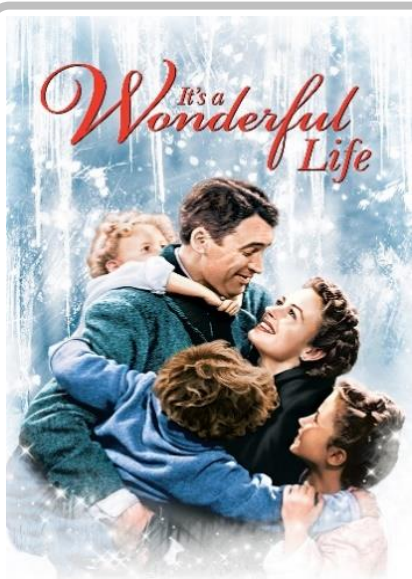


## Wednesdays in Advent Worship Services

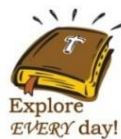
