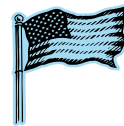

As many of you know, I am an extreme Dallas Cowboys fan. I bleed blue and silver. But right now, my team is struggling. They are 0-2. It looks like they may go 0-3 this weekend. Super Bowl favorite? Not right now! They are an extremely talented football team. They have the players to win. But they aren't performing their best. They are making uncharacteristic mistakes that are costing them games. Penalties, interceptions, and untimely fumbles are hurting their performance as a team. The teams that win are those that work together. The ones who win are those that figure out what is lacking in their game and work to fix the problems. Sometimes that means simplifying their game plan. Sometimes that means working harder on fundamentals. Sometimes it means extreme changes in certain areas of their team. This past Monday, the players got together without the coaches in order to hold each other accountable for their play. They took the blame for what happened on the field. I don't know if that will result in a win this Sunday, but at least they are doing something to try to make things work for their team.

Daniel was a man that loved God with all of his heart. He served God faithfully under the reign of the Babylonians, the Medes, and the Persians. He was a man of integrity and character. But even though he was obviously following God's plan, as he was praying and seeking God, he discovered that the reason his people were in slavery was because of sin. He examined himself and his team and found that they were lacking in some areas which were costing them their freedom. And even though he was serving God with all of his heart personally, he counted himself among those that had sinned and began to pray for forgiveness for his sin and the sins of his people. He asked for healing and restoration of his people. He asked for God to move so that His people would be restored to a right standing before God. And because of his prayer, God sent him an answer and promised deliverance and restoration for his people.

I want to be like Daniel. I know that every person, even if we love God and are serving God faithfully, need to examine our lives and ask God what areas of our lives need to change. We need to come together as a family and seek God, just like Daniel did, to ask for forgiveness and to ask for restoration from our God. God has so much He wants to do, but He can only do that if we are seeking after Him with all of our hearts. And I believe that if we do that, God will give us an answer and show us what He wants to do. Will you begin to pray, just like Daniel?
