Background Ministry Information for Dr. Gregory R. Frizzell

Prayer and Spiritual Awakening Specialist for the Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma And Missionary with the North American Mission Board.

Saved at the First Baptist Church in Lexington, Tennessee. He was called to the ministry at the age of 16 at First Baptist Church Lexington, Tennessee.

Earned a B.A. Degree from Union University, a Masters Degree from Southwestern Seminary and a Doctorate from New Orleans Seminary. During seminary, Dr. Frizzell served in a professional Christian counseling center. He also founded and led a prison ministry in the late 1970's.

Served nearly seventeen years as Pastor of Georgian Hills Baptist Church in Memphis, Tennessee. For ten years he directed the Spiritual Awakening Council of Shelby Baptist Association in Memphis, Tennessee.

Has conducted association, state, and national prayer conferences in most of our fifty states. Conducts national annual conventions and pastor's conferences in international conventions (Brazil, India, Russian/Ukraine, South America, etc.)

Works closely with Dr. Henry Blackaby in national prayer strategies. Served as a conference leader in 1994, 1995, 1996, and 2000 at Ridgecrest and Glorieta National Conference on Spiritual Awakening. In 1998, 1999, and 2000 served as national conference leader at Ridgecrest and Glorieta and various state conventions in the area of Prayer Evangelism. He has also been a keynote speaker at National Conferences. Frequently leads sessions in Great Commission Prayer conferences for the North American Mission Board. He is a contributing author in the major book, **A House of Prayer**, published by LifeWay.

In 1999, wrote a comprehensive statewide prayer strategy that is embraced by most of the state conventions. Several state conventions recently mailed Dr. Frizzell's books and resources to over 35,000 Southern Baptist Churches.

In 1997-2002, Dr. Frizzell produced and broadcast the multi-state radio ministries **God's Word for Today**, **Pastor's Forum** and **Toward the Next Great Awakening**.

Dr. Frizzell has written thirty books and resources on revival, united prayer strategies and spiritual awakening. His resources are currently available through the Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma Prayer Office and Master Design Ministries.

In 2001, Dr. Frizzell was employed as the Director of Prayer and Spiritual Awakening for the Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma. Dr. Frizzell is also an appointed missionary with the North American Mission Board with the specific responsibilities of church and association wide prayer and renewal. **He is also the president and founder of Gregory Frizzell Prayer & Renewal Ministries, Inc.** which is an international corporation of conferences and Christian publishing. Dr. Frizzell conducts extensive conferences for developing personal prayer, church prayer ministries, associational prayer strategies, powerful church prayer meetings, spiritual warfare, and solemn assemblies. His wife Sandy is also an author and conference leader.

Rehoboth Baptist Association 1st Annual Fishing Tournament



May 14-15, 2010

Lone Star Lake (Ellison Creek Reservoir)
Lakeview Baptist Assembly, Lone Star, TX
Tournament Headquarters

To participate in this event each participant must attend the Friday night dinner, hear our special guest speakers, and be present during the pre-tournament meeting.

Lodging will be provided by Lakeview Baptist Assembly as will all meals. Lodging in the motel style rooms is \$21/person when shared with another person, and \$31/person is for single rooms. These rooms are limited. Dorm accommodations are \$14/person and you will need to bring your own bedroll. The cost of all three meals (Friday night thru Saturday lunch) is \$14.50/person.

This is a team tournament with no more than 3 participants per boat. Bank fishing is also allowed if you fish from the Lakeview property. Entry fees are \$10/person for each category (Bass, Catfish, or Crappie) and \$1/person for the big fish in each category. Payouts are based on the number of teams. See the rules for more information on all topics.

Each team may weigh in up to 5 bass, 5 catfish, or 7 crappie to qualify in the total team weight category and each team may enter a fish in the big fish category of each species. While fishing for bass only artificial lures may be used but while fishing for catfish or crappie both artificial and live bait may be used. All state, federal and local laws must be obeyed. State regulations for minimum length will apply.

Payout will be based on the number of teams participating in each species. 1 to 9 teams pays two places ; 10 to 19 teams pays 3 places; 20 teams or more pays 5 places. Big fish in each species pays two places.

Launch times will be announced during Pre-Tournament meeting. Lake is off limits from 6 p.m. Friday until launch time Saturday. Weigh in will be at 12:00 p.m. It is each participants responsibility to understand and abide by the rules. Each participant must sign a Release of Liability to compete.

This event is about honoring God through Christian fellowship in a spirit of love for the sport of fishing and the fellow anglers while helping Lakeview Baptist Assembly.

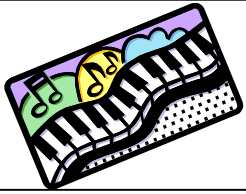

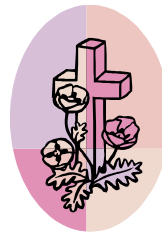
