Springtime – The Garden – A Reminder

Springtime is a grand theological reminder of the way God works in human life because it is also a time for gardens.

What happens in a garden? The primary characteristic of a garden is simply --Transformation. Things grow, change, and are transformed into what they are designed to be.

The overriding message of scripture is the way God has worked in our world to transform we human being into His image. In this, it is interesting to note what happened in biblical gardens.

Consider the transformations that took place in the Garden of Eden and the garden where Christ was resurrected.

In the Garden of Eden humanity, in the form of Eve, gave in to the tempter by eating the forbidden fruit then giving some to Adam. Consider the transformation. Individuals created in the image of God were transformed into disobedient human beings following their own wills.

In the Garden of the resurrection, however, humanity in the form of Mary Magdalene, refused to leave the garden until the Christ was found. Consider the transformation. Individuals in the resurrection garden are now on a quest to find God.

As a result, Mary Magdalene was the first to encounter the risen Christ and the first to go to the Apostles and tell them Christ is alive.

So, it is with us. Life as believers is meant to be transformative, life-changing. In springtime, the new foliage, new blooms, new life, the planting of gardens should serve as a reminder – transformative newness is always available to us.

The question then becomes, to what degree have we been transformed into what we are designed to be – a clearer, more righteous, image of God?

We are currently in our third year! This past year, BSUMC has distributed approximately 100 "donated" fleece throw blankets (size 50" by 60") among the four law enforcement departments in our local area. These blankets are used by police officers in the Bull Shoals, Lakeview, Flippin, and Marion County Sheriff's Office for those facing an emergency or immediate critical need.

I have heard personally from the men and women officers using there blankets in their efforts to serve our community. Whether it is a car accident, house fire, or caring for a child in distress, the blankets have been used and appreciated. One officer at the Marion County Sheriff Office said this to me, "There were times when if I had not had a blanket, the individual might not have made it." Hearing comments like that has renewed my commitment to continue with this ministry, but I could not do it without the generous support of everyone at BSUMC.

I want to thank you, one and all, for supporting this ministry another year through your donations of blankets and/or financial contributions. You have blessed me and the community through your love and support of the ministry.
