Children's Disaster Services Training Workshop

On October 5th and 6th NHCC will offer a workshop to train Children's Disaster Services volunteers in Central Oklahoma.

Children's Disaster Services has been meeting the needs of children since 1980, and is a Church of the Brethren Ministry working in cooperation with FEMA and the American Red Cross to provide care for children and families following disasters.

Children's Disaster Services volunteers provide a calm, safe, and reassuring presence in the midst of the chaos that follows disaster by setting up and operating special child care centers in disaster locations. Parents are then able to apply for assistance and begin to put their lives back together, knowing their children are safe.

Cost for the workshop is \$45 for early registration (by September 15th) or \$55 for registrations received less than three weeks before the workshop begins.
