

II CHRONICLES 6:19-42

Praying For A Nation

"But will God indeed dwell with men on the earth? Behold, heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot contain You. . . . Yet regard the prayer of Your servant and his supplication, O LORD my God, and listen to the cry and the prayer which Your servant is praying before You: . . . that You may hear the prayer which Your servant makes toward this place. And may You hear the supplications of Your servant and of Your people Israel . . . Hear from heaven Your dwelling place, and when You hear, forgive.

"If anyone sins against his neighbor . . . "Or if Your people Israel are defeated before an enemy because they have sinned against You . . . "When the heavens are shut up and there is no rain because they have sinned against You . . .

"When there is famine in the land, pestilence or blight or mildew, locusts or grasshoppers; when their enemies besiege them in the land of their cities; whatever plague or whatever sickness *there is*; whatever prayer, whatever supplication is *made* by anyone, or by all Your people Israel, when each one knows his own burden and his own grief, and spreads out his hands to this temple: then hear from heaven Your dwelling place, and forgive, and give to everyone according to all his ways, whose heart You know (for You alone know the hearts of the sons of men), that they may fear You, to walk in Your ways as long as they live in the land which You gave to our fathers . . .

"Moreover, concerning a foreigner, who is not of Your people Israel, but has come from a far country for the sake of Your great name and Your mighty hand and Your outstretched arm, when they come and pray in this temple; then hear from heaven Your dwelling place, and do according to all for which the foreigner calls to You, that all peoples of the earth may know Your name and fear You, as *do* Your people Israel, and that they may know that this temple which I have built is called by Your name.

"When Your people go out to battle against their enemies, wherever You send them, and when they pray to You . . . then hear from heaven their prayer and their supplication, and maintain their cause.

"When they sin against You (for *there is* no one who does not sin), and You become angry with them and deliver them to the enemy, and they take them captive to a land far or near; yet when they come to themselves in the land where they were carried captive, and repent, and make supplication to You in the land of their captivity, saying, 'We have sinned, we have done wrong, and have committed wickedness'; and *when* they return to You with all their heart and with all their soul in the land of their captivity, where they have been carried captive, and pray toward their land which You gave to their fathers, the city which You have chosen, and toward the temple which I have built for Your name: then hear from heaven . . . their prayer and their supplications, and maintain their cause, and forgive Your people who have sinned against You. Now, my God, I pray, let Your eyes be open and Your ears *be* attentive to the prayer *made* in this place.

"Now therefore, Arise, O LORD God, to Your resting place, You and the ark of Your strength. Let Your priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation, And let Your saints rejoice in goodness. "O LORD God, do not turn away the face of Your Anointed; Remember the mercies of Your servant David." NKJV
