No Sunday or Wednesday Night Services At This Time



This August will mark 9 years that our family packed up our only belongings in 14 suitcases and landed in Guatemala with our eyes wide open and not a clue in the world of what we were doing. Our hearts

have always been to be obedient to whatever the Lord asks of us.

I remember the culture shock, the language difficulty and the fear of forgetting we can't flush the toilet paper. Everything is new and so different. Yet so full of possibilities.

Village of Hope was birthed a little over a year after we landed on the grounds and it has evolved, grown and been molded into the vision the Lord gave us over the years.

With your help, we have now had the privilege of serving over 181 children on site at Village of Hope providing them with holistic care- educationally, physically, spiritually and emotionally since 2013. We have fed thousands of starving people in the community as well as filled the hungry bellies that call Village of Hope home. We've given a supportive home and hope to 21 adolescent mothers, and we helped them to safely deliver and care for their babies. We've shared Jesus daily, we've baptized new Believers, built authentic relationships with local Guatemalans, and stood in awe watching the gospel in action.

God has done exceedingly, abundantly more than we can think to ask through this vision He gave us for Village of Hope.

I once had someone ask what a typical day looks like here and our response is always "there is no typical day at Village of Hope." Each day is exciting in it's own way. We never knew if we'd be holding the hand of an 11-year-old giving birth, sitting in court fighting for a child, scrubbing toilets, delivering food, offering counseling, rocking a baby to sleep, baptizing former prostitutes, advocating for adoptions or coming alongside a family in orphan prevention.

But each night we'd fall asleep exhausted and wake up excited to see what Jesus would do next.

Last January as we prayed with our US board over 2020 we had no idea what the year would bring. But once again we were willing to serve the Lord in whatever capacity He asked.

Over the next several months we would go back to those conversations we had with our US board in January and ask the Lord how to meet all of the ministry needs and serve Him best. We have felt the Lord guiding us into a new area of the ministry as Stateside Directors. While this position will again bring change, and change can always be challenging-we are excited to be able to connect with churches, partners, advocate, plan short term missions trips, fundraise and more in this new season. We know the Lord will do so much through this role to grow the ministry in ways we couldn't have otherwise.

We have raised up a team here in Guatemala that is now trained, capable and ready with our daughter Addisyn and son-in-law Ronald. Addisyn and Ronald are fully equipped in unique God given ways to lead here on the grounds so we can fill other areas of need. Todd and I are excited to have a home base in the states now where we can transition our children into young adulthood while also going back and forth between the US and Guatemala working full time from both places.

We are so grateful for our partners who have made ALL of this possible and we will continue to need your support like never before as we continue to live fully off support.
