The "Guat Trot" fundraiser has \$2900 sponsored most of which has been collected. Youth sent letters asking friends and relatives to donate toward the purchase of their tickets. Proceeds apply to the youth mission trip to Village of Hope Orphanage for special needs children in Guatemala.

The Mission and OutReach Team voted to use the WCBC Mission budget to retire a debt owed by missionaries and to help in an adoption process of a Chinese orphan.
