NOTE: By signing the Kamp Keirsey registration form, the Parent verifies that both the Parent and the camper understands, accepts and will abide by the "Camper Rules" and further understands that if the camper goes beyond the scope of these rules that the Parent may be called upon to come and take the camper home at the discretion of the camp leadership.

## **CAMPER RULES**

- **1.** Camp is a group activity; let's work as a group by following all instructions given by the camp staff.
- **2.** Strive to learn all you can from camp.
- **3.** Be at each service on time.
- 4. Cabin leaders and campers are expected to participate in the entire camp program. In order that children will not want to go home early, we ask that family not visit your child until the last day of camp. All visitors must check in with the Camp Manager, Camp Director or Assistant Director.
- **5.** Show a Christian spirit at all times. If you have a problem, please go to your cabin leader or other adult.
- **6.** No personal display of affection or "PDA."
- <u>7.</u> All clothing must be modest. No halter tops, midriffs, T-shirts with large cut out sleeves, jogging shorts, shorts with slits, athletic shorts or spandex.
- 8. The swimming pool is for everyone's enjoyment, but only those who have brought permission from their parents will be allowed to swim. Bring swimwear that is appropriate for a Christian Camp this means no 2-piece swim wear. Camp provides 2 Red Cross certified lifeguards and we have camp personnel on duty to help supervise pool activities. The camp board sets the rules and we are expected to abide by them.
- <u>9.</u> There are to be no radios, tape players, electronic communication or entertainment devices allowed at camp by campers or cabin leaders. (Examples: cell phones, personal computers, pagers, etc.)
- **10.** Keep rooms clean at all times. Keep grounds clean so that the camp will be ready for the next group to come to Kamp Keirsey.
- 11. No food or drinks in the cabins. (This attracts bugs and rodents which in turn attract snakes.)
- 12. Cots are not to be moved in or out of the cabins without consent of the Camp Manager or Director.
- **13.** Mattress covers are not to be removed.
- **14.** No rock throwing of any kind.
- **15.** Firearms and fireworks are positively prohibited during times of encampment.
- 16. No cabin or dorm raiding. If this occurs, severe punishment or dismissal may occur
- 17. If you should become ill, report to the Director or Camp Manager right away.
- **18.** Tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, gambling, profane or vulgar language, and disorderly conduct are positively prohibited at any and all times. Such substances are hazardous to your health and to the wildlife.
- <u>19.</u> No phone calls are to be made except in case of emergency of which the Camp Manager of Director will make the call. Do not ask your child to call you from camp.
- **20.** Before checking out from camp, see that you have cleaned your cabin, picked up all the litter and that everything you have used is in good order.
- <u>21.</u> All medications must by checked-in by parents at the time of registering even over-the-counter medications.
- 22. The decision of the Camp Manager or Director is final on questionable situations.
