The Bolivian Baptist Union has invited International Commission to partner with 70 churches in an evangelistic project in Cochabamba.

Nearby La Paz is the Capital of the country and is about 11, 900 feet above sea level. The city sits in a "bowl" surrounded by high mountains. This region also includes the most humid area of the high Andean plain with an average of 25" of precipitation annually.

Almost 80% of the population in Bolivia is Roman Catholic, and many protestant churches have mixed beliefs with the indigenous traditions. The Baptist churches in the region of La Paz are planning to be a model to the evangelical communities in the country, bringing them to unity in reaching out to the lost souls in their country, and changing the spiritual condition of their country.

Jesus said, *"The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field"* Matthew 9:36-37. The Baptist churches in Cochabamba are praying for workers to come. Would you and your church accept the call to go and be a part of this great harvest?
