

ADDITIONAL CHOIR INFORMATION  
GRADES 1-8

Singing in the choir at Redeemer Lutheran School is a blessing to everyone! As a student, you are learning music and singing skills that you can use your entire life. It is an easy way for you to witness to those around you, including your family and the church congregation. Many people are blessed by hearing the message you are proclaiming in song. To God be the Glory!

Here are a few things you need to know about Choir for grades 1-8:

\*You need to be at church 20 minutes before the service begins for warm-ups and seating assignments. We will typically sing the prelude and anthem.

\*We will sit up in the balcony as a choir during the service. Students will stay upstairs and participate, and teachers will supervise.

\*If you need to leave the service early to worship at your home church, you may come upstairs and get your child after the Gospel lesson is read and we are seated for the sermon hymn, about 20 minutes after church begins. Please notify your teacher if this will be happening.

\*Your attendance and participation at the choir dates listed is required. Choir is part of your music grade and counts towards your GPA.

\*Prior to the dates we sing, a reminder form will be sent home. It is to be signed and returned to your teacher.

\*In the event that you cannot be there to sing on a Sunday service, you may complete a special assignment that will "excuse" you from being at church to sing. It is due the day following the service that you miss. When you return your reminder form, your teacher will give you that assignment.

\*If you miss due to an illness, you must notify your teacher to be counted as excused. (No assignment will need to be done.)

\*Failure to do the assignment, or to notify your teacher of an illness, will result in a "0" grade for that day.

\*The Musical and the Fine Arts Festival are required and cannot be made up with an assignment.
