School Immunization Requirements

When a student enrolls in a school for the first time and at any level, his/her parents/guardians must show either that he/she has been immunized or that a current religious or medical objection is on file. Parents/Guardians must provide the school with complete immunization records prior to the beginning of the school year.

3 to 5 years old Preschool

3 Hep. B (Hepatitis B), 4 DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, & Pertussis), 3 Polio, 1 MMR (Measles, Mumps & Rubella), and 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox or date of disease)

K -1st grade

3 Hep B , 5 DTaP, 4 Polio, 2 MMR, 2 Varicella, and 2 Hep A (Hepatitis A)

Grades 2 to 5

3 Hep B, 5 DTaP, 4 Polio, 2 MMR, and 2 Varicella

Grades 6 to 11

3 Hep B, 5 DTaP, 4 Polio, 2 MMR, 2 Varicella, 1 Tdap (Tetanus & Pertussis) and 1 MCV4 (Meningococcal)

If your child is not immunized due to religious or medical reasons, you must submit a dated statement with parent/guardian signature (or Doctor signature if medical) indicating so each year your child is enrolled in school.
