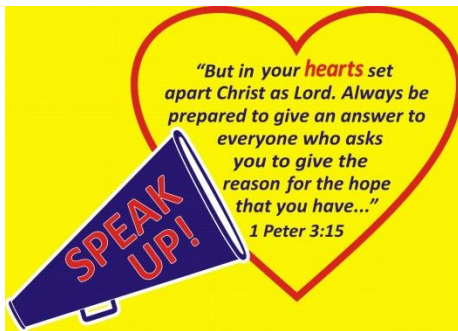

School Bells
