


Dear Church Family,

There is a verse I want you to consider. It is found in Hebrews 2:1, "Therefore we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away." This verse was written to Jewish Believers who were endanger of forsaking their walk with Christ and going back into Judaism.
