Therefore, at the same time, we will be showing another movie for children entitled "The Ten Commandments." This is an animated feature that tells the story of the Ten Commandments in an interesting and exciting way for children.

While this article sounds more like a promotion for the films—and it is that—it is more. I write this because it is based on Bible truth, which is relevant to all areas of life. God says, "You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free" (John 8:32).

Our desire is to teach the truth so that young women will be able to escape the emotional and physical pain of abortion and so that those who have been through an abortion may come to know the forgiveness of God and the peace of heart they are searching for.

But you don't need to see the movie to find that. Jesus is available now if you will just ask him to forgive your sins and to give you peace in your heart. If you are hurting, without peace, and searching for love, He is just waiting for you to do that. Invite Him to reveal Himself to you. Invite Him to meet you where you are.
