From the Desk of Your Missionary

"I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings (Presidents), and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour." (I Timothy 2:1-3)

Friends, if there ever was a time to pray for our leaders, especially for the President, that time is NOW! The man in the White House not

only has a direct impact in the lives of every American, but also the lives of millions around the world (especially those in Afghanistan today).

Whether you think his decision to withdraw our troops from Afghanistan was a wise decision or not; whether you think the timeliness of his decision was correct or not; regardless of what you or I think, his decision is impacting the lives of hundreds of thousands of Afghanistan citizens. Many of those who are being affected are Christians or Christian workers.

Whether you think the man in the White House was duly elected or not, more than ever, he needs the prayers of Christians.
