BIBLICAL REFLECTIONS

It's Not About Me (Part 2)

Sometimes God's rules feel REALLY restrictive, right? I mean, how much stuff do people around you get away with—and feel perfectly okay with—that you're not supposed to do? There's the big stuff: hooking up, having sex, going to parties, or getting drunk. There's lying. Honestly, sometimes following Jesus feels like losing all your freedom. But is that true? Is growing as a disciple in Christ really worth it?

John 8:31-32

Jesus said to the people who believe in him, "You are truly my disciples if you remain faithful to my teachings. And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

Romans 6:7

For when we died with Christ we were set free from the power of sin.

1 Peter 5:8

Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.

- † Jesus died so that you could be free. Spend some time thanking Him for that. Also, ask Him to help you stay obedient to Him today so that you can STAY in that freedom.
- † The Bible says Satan's like a lion looking to kill people. But it ALSO says we've been freed from him and don't have to fear him anymore. This might seem weird, but ask Jesus to protect you today from Satan's lies.
- † Talk to God about any prayer requests, concerns, or stresses in your life right now. Remember, He LIKES talking to you!
