BIBLICAL REFLECTIONS

How Trying Really Hard to Grow Fruit is Dumb

Has there ever been a more boring word than “discipleship”? I mean, if you know what it actually means (being an every-second student of Jesus) it’s kind of cool. But if we’re honest, most of us hear the word and either stifle a yawn or an unpleasant shudder. I believe the reason for this is that when we think of discipleship, we also think of the word “discipline.” And discipline sounds like trying really hard to do something I hate doing. (Is this just me?) Is this all “growing in Jesus” means?

John 15:5-10

“Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in me is thrown away like a useless branch and withers. Such branches are gathered into a pile to be burned. But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted! When you produce much fruit, you are my true disciples. This brings great glory to my Father.

“I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love. When you obey my commandments, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father’s commandments and remain in his love.”

† **Here’s the truth:** YOU don’t make yourself into a person God wants you to be. HE does that. So what role do we have in that process? We stay connected to Him. And then when life gets difficult we lean on Him to make us the kind of person who gets through it.
