BIBLICAL REFLECTIONS

The More You Know

If there's one thing most people hate, it's a reading assignment. You might even LOVE reading, but the moment someone tells you that you HAVE to read it, you think, "I'm not doing that!" This is true sometimes with the Bible. We're not opposed to reading it—in theory—but feeling like we're SUPPOSED to read it can make us think, "I'm not doing that!" But if the Bible really IS God's love letter to us, maybe we should think about it differently. Maybe we might even (gasp!) grow to like reading it!

2 Timothy 3:16-17

You have been taught the holy Scriptures from childhood, and they have given you the wisdom to receive the salvation that comes by trusting in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.

- † Talk to God about the Bible. If you LOVE reading it, thank Him for it. If—like most people—it's kind of hard for you to read it sometimes, ask Him for help. Specifically, ask God to give you a desire to read it. He LOVES it when you ask for His help.
- † Ask God to help you understand what you're reading in the Bible, from this time forward. This would actually be a good thing to pray every time you go to read the Bible!
- † Spend some time talking to God about whatever is on your mind today.
