BIBLICAL REFLECTIONS

This is Your Brain on God

So there were these crazy commercials a few years back—you may have seen them—that showed a normal egg and said, “This is your brain.” Then they’d crack the egg over a sizzling skillet. The yolk would immediately start frying, and the announcer would say, “This is your brain on drugs. Any questions?” I mention this because if we’re really going to grow to be more like Jesus, we have to stop frying our brains. Seriously. So much of the stuff we watch, listen to, read, and talk about fries our brain to the point where we can’t think of things the way God does. (Even us adults and long time “Christians” have this problem!) But it doesn’t have to be like that.

Philippians 4:8

And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise.

- † This verse lists eight different characteristics of the things we should fill our lives with. Which words stand out to you? What do you think they mean?
- † Make a quick list of TV shows you watch, bands you listen to, or books you read. How many of them fit the words from this verse? (note: Just because something isn’t obviously labeled “Christian” doesn’t mean it is or isn’t healthy. Honestly evaluate the effect these things have on you.)
- † Think about your conversations. What conversations do you have that don’t qualify as being true, honorable, pure, or worthy of praise? Is there a specific area where you seem to say or do things that don’t fall into this category?
- † This verse isn’t about what we DON’T do. It’s more about what we DO. What are things in your life that DO fit this verse? What are things in your life that you could add that fit this verse?
