BIBLICAL REFLECTIONS

On the TV show “Lost,” one of the main characters—a guy named Jack—uttered a phrase that would become famous throughout the run of the show: “We can either live together, or die alone.” Now, we don’t live on a freaky island that makes us see dead people or that has smoke monsters (yep, both from the show), but we DO live in a world where it’s tough to honor Jesus. You might remember that Satan, our enemy, is like a lion out hunting his prey (us). So what do we do as Christians? Well... we live together, or die alone.

Ecclesiastes 4:9-12

⁹ *Two are better than one,*

Because they have a good reward for their labor.

¹⁰ *For if they fall, one will lift up his companion.*

But woe to him who is alone when he falls,

For he has no one to help him up.

¹¹ *Again, if two lie down together, they will keep warm;*

But how can one be warm alone?

¹² *Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him.*

And a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

- † Maybe today as you were reading this, God brought up some stuff in your life that you know you need to ask others for help with (maybe a Christian friend or a pastor or Sunday School teacher). Ask God for help in 1) knowing how to fix it and 2) having the courage to fix it.
- † Do you have a friend that you know is struggling with something? Pray for that person. Ask God to show you ways you can help your friend today.
- † Thank God for sending Jesus to die for you. That seems a little off-topic, but it all comes back to your relationship with God. Ask Him for help with whatever you know you’re going to need today. Ask Him for help in loving Him through your actions today.
