BIBLICAL REFLECTIONS

What is Mine, Is Yours

We don't exactly live in a culture that's big on community. It's not uncommon to live just a few houses down from people but never meet them. Sure we have friends, classmates, and co-workers, but for the most part, we keep them at a certain distance. For instance how many people really know some of the stuff you're struggling with the most right now? Not everyone needs to know every detail of your life—that's for sure—but God's plan for Christians is to have a community that we can depend on ...for everything.

Acts 4:32-37

³² And the congregation of those who believed were of one heart and soul; and not one *of them* claimed that anything belonging to him was his own, but all things were common property to them. ³³ And with great power the apostles were giving testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and abundant grace was upon them all. ³⁴ For there was not a needy person among them, for all who were owners of land or houses would sell them and bring the proceeds of the sales ³⁵ and lay them at the apostles' feet, and they would be distributed to each as any had need.

³⁶ Now Joseph, a Levite of Cyprian birth, who was also called Barnabas by the apostles (which translated means Son of ^[d]Encouragement),³⁷ and who owned a tract of land, sold it and brought the money and laid it at the apostles' feet.

† God clearly wants us to live in community with other Christians, where we look out for each other's needs. If you have Christian friends that you do life with—especially if you're in a small group—pray that God would help you see how you can serve them this week.

† If you are not a part of a regular Christian community—a small group, a youth ministry, whatever—pray that God would help you find one or meet people you can do life with.
