BIBLICAL REFLECTIONS

Grudges, Lies, and other Community-Killers

God wants Christians to be unified—to be of one mind and heart. So why do we spend so much of our time fighting? Why are some churches known as places where people get hurt or are excluded? It's because we don't take seriously the following verses...

Ephesians 4:25-29

²⁵ So stop telling lies. Let us tell our neighbors the truth, for we are all parts of the same body. ²⁶ And "don't sin by letting anger control you. "Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry, ²⁷ for anger gives a foothold to the devil.

²⁸ If you are a thief, quit stealing. Instead, use your hands for good hard work, and then give generously to others in need. ²⁹ Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.

- † Some pretty obvious stuff to pray about today. If you're dealing with anger or lying, talk to God about it. Ask Him to help you see why you do that. Tell Him you know you want to stop but need His help.
- † Continue to ask God to give you healthy friendships with other Christians. Pray that God would make you the kind of influence on other Christians that would help them become who God created them to be.
- † This passage says "don't sin by letting anger control you." What do you think the difference is between being angry and being controlled by anger? How does the second half of vs. 26 keep that from happening?
- † Why do you think Satan is so determined to keep Christians from living healthily together? Is there any way he's using you to create problems?
