BIBLICAL REFLECTIONS

One

The Bible teaches that God is one God. One. That's it. But it also teaches that this one God exists simultaneously in three parts: God the Father, God the Son (Jesus), and God the Holy Spirit. God is not three separate gods. And Jesus and the Holy Spirit are not lesser gods. He's one God in three parts. Weird, huh? But it's also one of the coolest ideas in the Bible. And it gets even cooler when you read verses like the one below.

John 17:20-23

²⁰ "I am praying not only for these disciples but also for all who will ever believe in me through their message. ²¹ I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me.

²² "I have given them the glory you gave me, so they may be one as we are one. ²³ I am in them and you are in me. May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me..

† In vs 20 Jesus prays specifically for you. Think about that—Jesus prayed for you! Jesus—God who became a human. And He prayed for you. Spend some time thinking about it—that the God of the universe prayed for you by name. Spend some time thanking God for loving you and knowing you that well.

† Unity among Christians is a bid deal. God wants us to love each other. To work together. To tell the truth to each other. To no be divided and argumentative. Pray that God would help you be unified with the Christ-followers around you. Pray for the times when that's really hard.
