BIBLICAL REFLECTIONS

It's Not About Us (Ministry)

Previously we talked about how God isn't a genie that exists to fulfill our needs. But there's another way that it's "not about me." A lot of times we view people for what we can get out of them. We try to avoid people who make us uncomfortable or need something from us, and we spend time around people who make us feel valued or that we think we can get something out of. This is human nature. And it's not how God wants us to be.

1 Corinthians 9:19

Even though I am a free man with no master, I have become a slave to all people to bring many to Christ.

Galatians 5:13-14

For you have been called to live in freedom, my brothers and sisters. But don't use your freedom to satisfy your sinful nature. Instead, use your freedom to serve one another in love. For the whole law can be summed up in this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

- † The Bible says elsewhere in that we have freedom in Christ. In other words, our salvation doesn't come from following rules; it comes from what Jesus did for us. So theoretically we could do whatever we want. But what does Galatians 5:13 say we should do with our freedom?
- † Serving others instead of ourselves is one of the hardest things in the world to do. Ask God to help you have a servant's heart. Pray that He would show you areas where He wants you to be more of a servant.
- † Spend time praying for people in your life that you know need prayer. Ask God to show you how you can show them love today.
