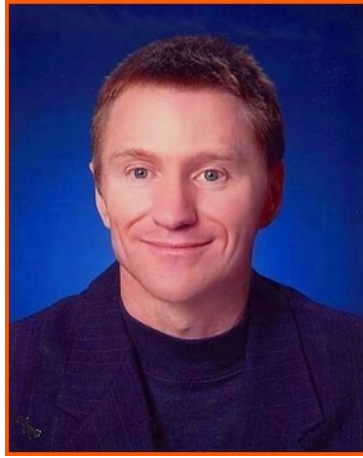
Sunday School Training Coming Up October 11, 2015 @ FBC Denver City!
