Summer Mission Opportunity

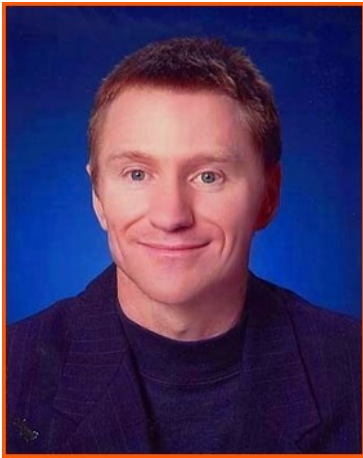
