Centennial Church Family

I have been praying for direction from the Lord for Centennial and myself concerning Spiritual Awakening, Discipleship, and Evangelism. I have had a vision for Centennial for 8 years. This vision includes us being an Acts 1:8 and a Great Commission Church simultaneously, and I believe that the Lord has given me tools and a 3 year plan to make this vision into a reality. The tools that God has placed in my hands are His Holy Word, Prayer, and 3 books by Robert Loggins. The Word, and prayer are self explanatory, but let me explain the use of the other resources to you.

YEAR 1 - 2011

The first year we will use a book entitled, "The Journey to Wholeness and Holiness". This is a 40 day Guide for Prayer, Fasting and Discipleship. The implementation of this resource into the life of Centennial Baptist Church will happen over the course of the coming year. This resource will encourage God's Church to be a people of prayer and if we are ever to become the people that God wants us to be we must become a people who are communicating and connecting with God through prayer. The first leg of our Journey to be the people of God will happen in 7 deliberate steps and they are as follows:

Step 1- Pray from Start to finish

Step 2- Pray and set date to have the Journey Workshop: includes break out groups. This is an all day event: 9:00 AM- 4:00 PM that allows you to understand how to pray and fast for personal spiritual awakening. Possible Date: March 19, 2011.

Step 3- Pray and enlist and recruit facilitators for the breakout groups.

Step 4- Pray and set date for Bob Loggins to come and facilitate training for facilitators. It is a 2 hour training. Possible Date: March 9, 2011 6-8 PM.

Step 5- Pray and order the 3 workbooks for this awakening seminar. (3 books for \$ 10.00 per person)

Step 6- Church begins 40 days of prayer and fasting while I preach on the topics of drawing close to God. Possible start date March 20th.

Step 7- Solemn Assembly- Church Family comes together at the culmination of the period of fasting and prayer for concentrated soul searching. Possible date: May 1st

YEAR 2 - 2012

In the second year of the plan we will utilize two more resources that were authored by Bob Loggins. They are a book that is entitled, "Preaching for Spiritual Awakening" and a Workbook that goes along with this book. This is a wonderful book that speaks to the hearts of individuals about genuine repentance and Spiritual Awakening. It challenges us to take more real steps towards being the people of God both corporately as the Body of Christ and individually as a person that is sold out to God. Many people in our congregation have already started reading this book and it has had a phenomenal effect upon their walk with the Lord. The steps for the Lord to transform us in this second year are as follows:

Step 1- Pray (throughout the process)

Step 2- Set a date for this Spiritual emphasis in 2012

Step 3- Purchase the book and read it as a church family while I simultaneously preach on topics addressed in the resource. Prayerfully set ending date for reading the book so that we may move to Step 4.

Step 4 Pray once the church family has completed reading PSA. Then a date will be set with the Prayer and Spiritual Awakening Spiritual Specialist to come in and lead the church family in a Church-wide Preaching for Spiritual Awakening Conference/Workshop. The Conference/Workshop will begin on Saturday night at 6:00 or 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 or 9:00 p.m. Then on Sunday at the regular worship hour, the Prayer and Spiritual Awakening Specialist will Preach for Spiritual Awakening, while at the same time encouraging the congregation to invite friends and family members to attend. Then a church-wide banquet or Sunday meal will conclude with fellowship, certificates, awards, prizes, music, and testimonies.

YEAR 3 - 2013

In the third year our emphasis will turn to evangelism and personal discipleship, and we will utilize a Soul Winning 50 day Devotional that was authored by Bob Loggins. This encourages each Christian to lead one person to Christ everyday for 50 days. I pray that we can utilize this plan along with a commitment to Disciple these individuals in the Lord. It will take each person approximately a year to adequately disciple a new Christian. At the end of that year you and the new convert commit to discipling another individual. Do you realize what kind of impact this would make on Mexico and the World? If 5 members commit to reach one person per year and disciple them to become reproductive believers the results would be as follows: Year 1= 10 believers, Year 2= 20 believers, Year 3= 40 believers, year 4= 80 believers, year 5= 160 believers, year 6= 320 believers, year 7= 640 believers, year 8= 1,280 believers, year 9= 2,560 believers, year 10= 5,120 believers. These believers will be disciplined, and plugged in to ministry, this means we will retain them as members. This is exciting! The steps to implementing this process in God's Church will be as follows:

Step 1- Pray

Step 2 - Set date for Soul Winning Workshop

Step 3- Order Manuals

Step 4- Pray, Fast, and Read the Manual for 50 Days as a Church Family while at the same time I preach on Soul Winning.

Step 5- Each member engages in Personal Evangelism.

Step 6- Pray once the church family has completed 50 Days of Soul Winning and Fasting and Praying. Then a date will be set for The Soul Winning Daily Devotional Manual Celebration. The celebration will occur on Sunday at the regular worship hour. The congregation will be encouraged to invite friends and family members to attend the celebration. Then a church-wide banquet or Sunday meal will conclude with fellowship, certificates, awards, prizes, music, and testimonies, videos, photos, stories, and much more will be celebrated on that day.

Step 7- Continue Soul Winning, Discipleship and Prayer.

One can see that if this plan is followed and implemented Centennial will become both an Acts 1:8 and Great Commission Church, and the Church will be disciple. Ffantastic growth will take place, and God will be glorified. Will you prayerfully join me on this journey, and commit to becoming the disciple and the maker of disciples that God is calling all of us to be? If you will, God will do great things and He will be glorified.

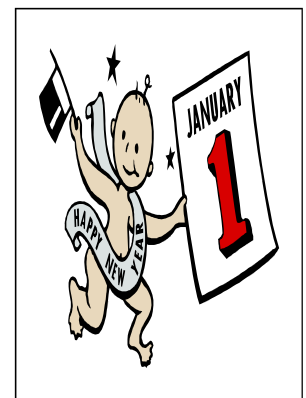

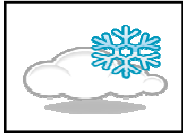

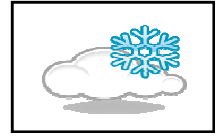
