Our WIC program (special supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants and Children) is a nutritional program that aims to keep clients healthy by providing them supplemental food and education.

To qualify for WIC, clients must meet certain income guidelines and show a nutritional need for the services.

Those who qualify receive food instruments in the form of a check that can be redeemed at participating grocery stores for certain nutritional foods.

WIC is held at the Audrain City-Co. Health Unit (573) 581-1332) every Tuesday by appointment only. It is also available in Vandalia on the second Thursday by appointment only.

DO MY WORDS BRING HURT OR HEALING?

I am a pastor's daughter. Well-meaning people in the church criticized my behavior or gave me pointed advice on everything from attending meetings to praying aloud to making the right kind of friends. As I grew older, I became sensitive to others' opinions. I resisted listening to advice and often attempted to act on my own without asking for help.

Recently, I was having trouble putting a battery in a power tool when I heard a voice cheerfully say, If you

were doing that backwards, would you want to know?" The question made me laugh, and I suddenly realized that my attitude determines whether advice is helpful or hurtful.

God is the author of helpful instructions, but whether or not I welcome the Bible's words of encouragement and direction is up to me. No matter how mature I am, I'll always need help. As my friend might ask, "If you were letting pride get in the way of accepting encouragement and power from God, would you want to know? My answer is yes!

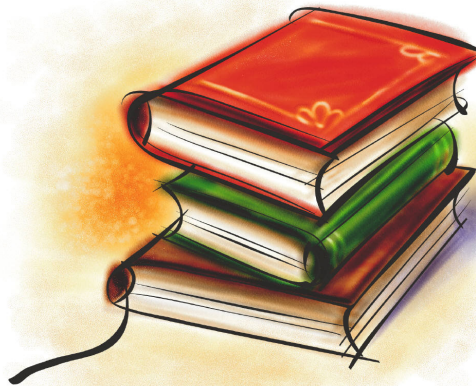
