



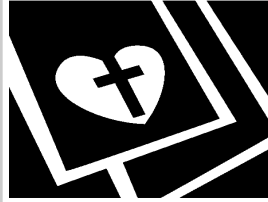

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

You think it's hot here??

If you can't stand the heat—better make plans to avoid it!

In debt? Jesus saves!

I am writing this as I prepare to go on the mission trip to North Dakota. I am thinking about how we need to engage our community more with "Gospel Conversations. When we go on the mission field, we are acutely aware of how little time that we actually have to share Jesus with the people that we drove 20 hours to get to. The result is that we are thinking about this all the time that we are on the trip.

One thing that happens on these trips is that there is accountability. We are asked every evening about how many Gospel Conversations did we have, and how many accepted Jesus for the first time. When you are asked point blank, it really makes you think. The truth is that not every conversation will turn into a gospel conversation or even a spiritual conversation, but it is always on our minds.

You might be wondering what the difference between a spiritual conversation and a gospel conversation is. First, it is a conversation. There are questions and answers, it is not just a lecture. I try and present the gospel message clearly from the pulpit each week, but that is not a gospel conversation. In the same way conversations about spiritual things aren't always gospel conversations. We can talk religion, without the gospel. Sometimes this happens on the reservation.

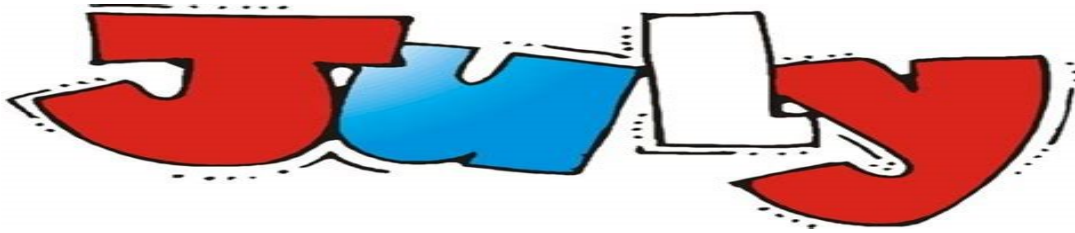
