MISSION TRIP

Have you ever dreamed of serving the Lord on a Mission Trip, but you thought I can't afford it or I don't want to travel a long distance. I have the answer to your prayers. You can serve the Lord right here in our Association August 3rd through August 7th at our 1st annual Royal Ambassador Camp and it will cost you half a tank of gas and a week of vacation. This is going to be a fun filled week in which the boys of Missouri will be touched with the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and they will be challenged to put the Gospel into practice in their everyday lives. Would you be willing to help us? We currently need:

1. **A Counselor (we need 9 men)-** Your responsibilities would include taking 10 boys to their many activities during the week, sharing the Gospel with them through devotions, showing the love and compassion of Jesus Christ, and bunking with them each night. You will have an adult bunk mate, and you will have activities instructors that will teach classes to them.
2. **Kitchen Staff- (we need 8 volunteers)** Your responsibilities will include helping to cook and serve the meals to the boys. Gene Young is in charge of the kitchen.
3. **Craft Instructors (we need 3)-** Your responsibilities will include helping the boys with their crafts. 20 Boys will be in your station at a time. The counselors will be there to assist you during this activity.

Youth Missions to North Dakota

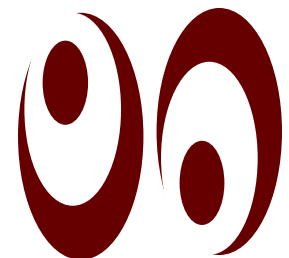
The application form for the youth mission trip to North Dakota, July 10-18, can be downloaded from our GCBA website.

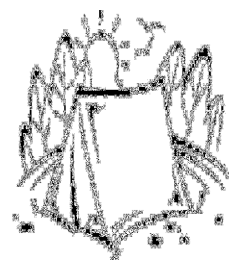
