SEED GROWTH

I learned about farming from my father who was a cotton farmer. Preparation for the next year's harvest actually starts just as the current year's harvest is complete. As soon as the crops are out of the field, the ground is prepared for the next year's crop to eliminate stalks and preserve ground moisture. The following spring and summer everything is done with precision, from selecting seed and the number to be planted per acre to plowing and planting.

However, regardless of how much preparation takes place, variables can always affect the plan. Insects, hail damage, too little or too much rainfall—all these can increase stress levels for farmers. Even though farmers have a lot of work and planning to do, they cannot make the seed sprout or the plant grow. Only God can do that.

Our spiritual growth is similar. Just as God cannot produce a crop for a farmer who does not plant and tend the field, God cannot grow the fruit of the Holy Spirit in our lives if we do not do our part. Our part involves consistent attention to spiritual practices such as Bible study, prayer, worship, putting God first in our lives and caring for those in need. It takes time to grow spiritually, and we cannot make it happen faster. But we can maximize our growth by paying attention every day to the details that are our responsibility.

PRAYER: Dear God, teach us to use the tools you have given us and to grow in spiritual maturity. AMEN

Welcome Canaan as a new Christian and member at CBC.



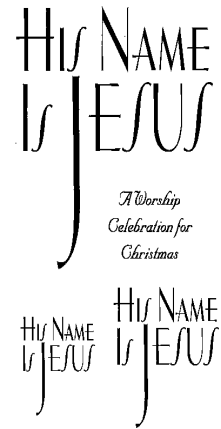
RACHEL MARQUETTE

According to the IMB's 2009 statistical data, there were 506,019 baptisms and 24,650 churches started in 2008.

Here's a global snapshot of challenges:

- 4,743 people groups not engaged at all with the Gospel.
- 6,426 unreached people groups (those

with less than 2% of people who profess to have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ).

- 1.7 billion with little or no access to the Gospel.
- 1.5 billion Muslims—22% of the world's population.
- 950 million Hindus in the world.
- Christian witness among China cities less than 1%.
- 355 million in South America do not know Christ.
- Less than 1% of Christian among more than 270 million living in Central Asia region.

- 97% of all Palestinians are Muslim.
- 89% of North African & Middle Eastern people groups are unreached.
- 311 people groups in India have no known evangelical believers.
