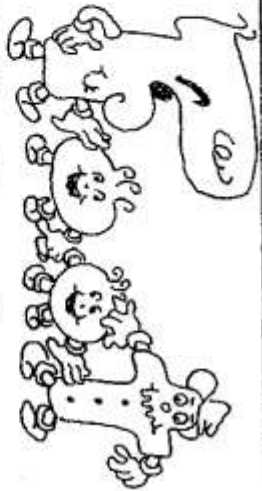
Our memory sentence is - "Enjoy songs imparting Jesus' love." Our word to remember this week is Enjoy.

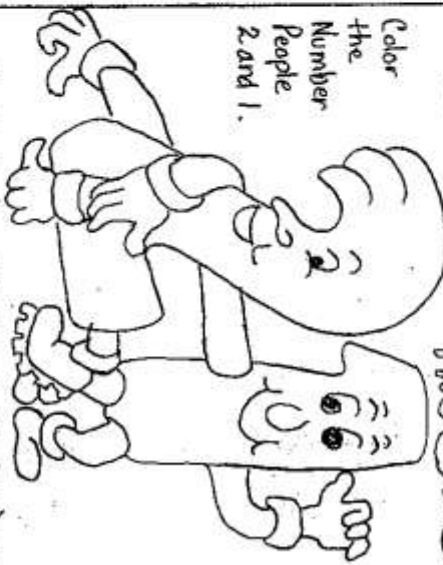

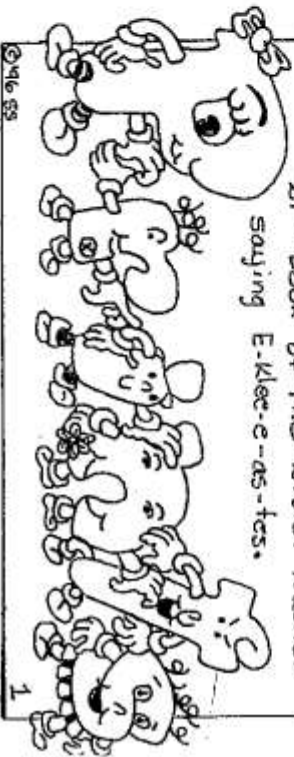


BOOKS of the BIBLE

Color the Number People 2 and 1.



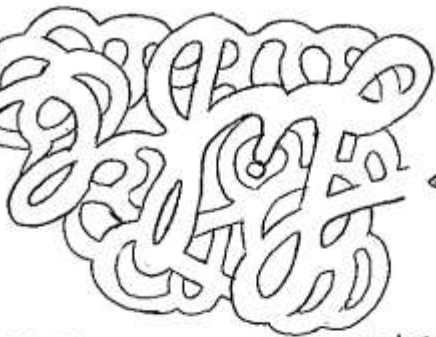
Ecclesiastes (E-klee-e-as-tes) is the 21st book of the Bible. Practice saying E-klee-e-as-tes.

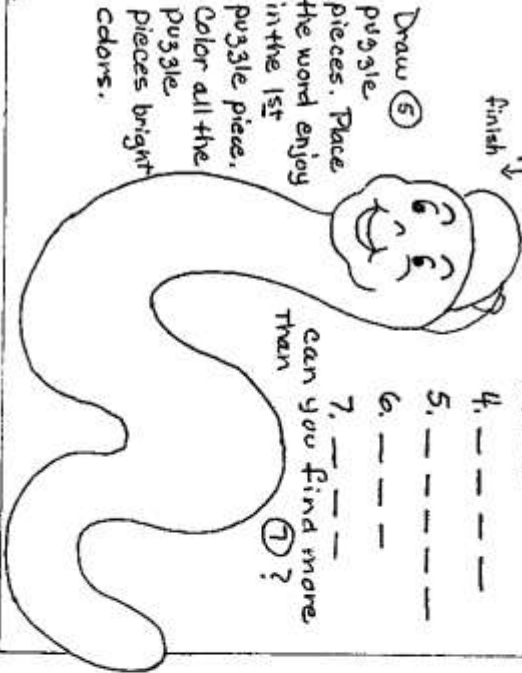
