

# THIS WEEK

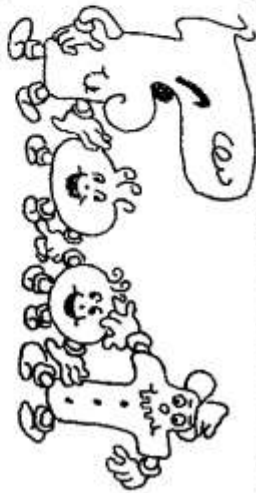
Our memory sentence is--"Every day holds joy abounding." Our word to remember this week is holds

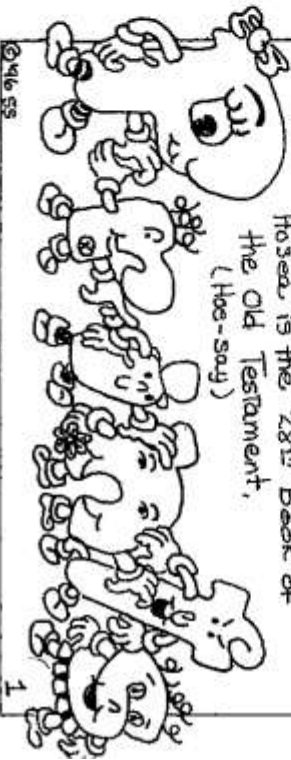

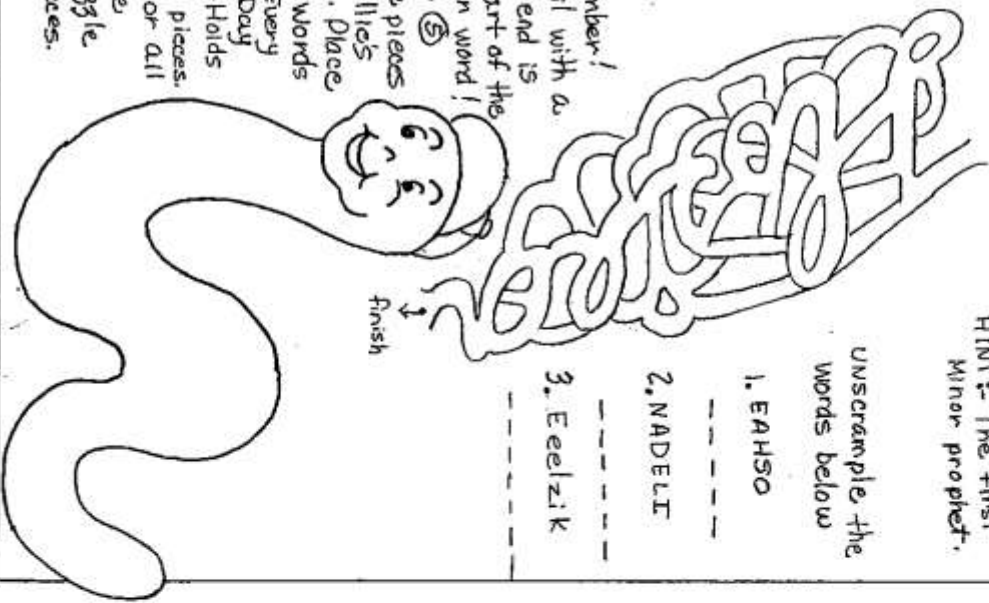

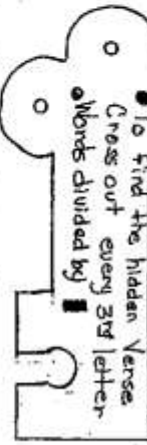
