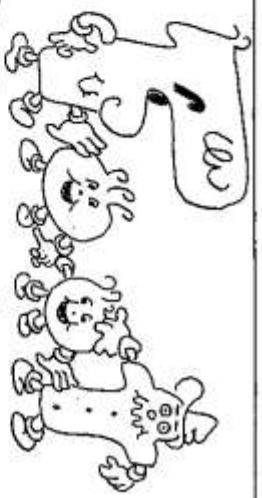
Our memory sentence is- "Never evade joyful personal prayer. Our word this week to remember is joyful."

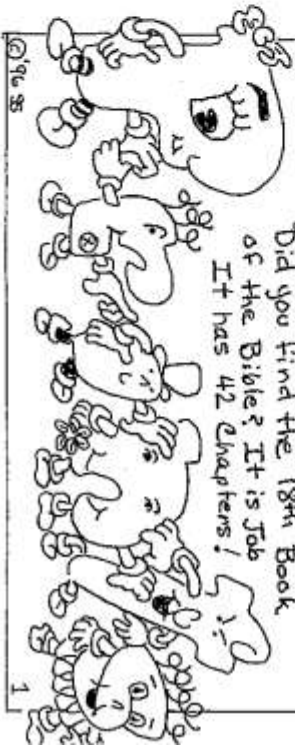

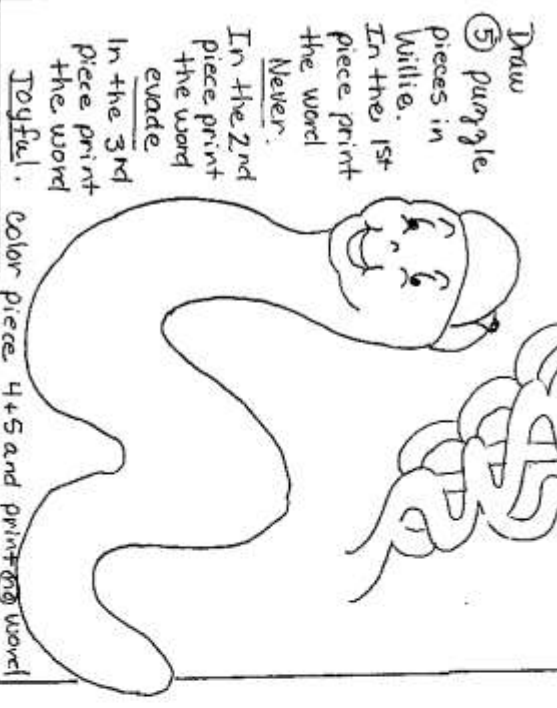
