

THIS WEEK

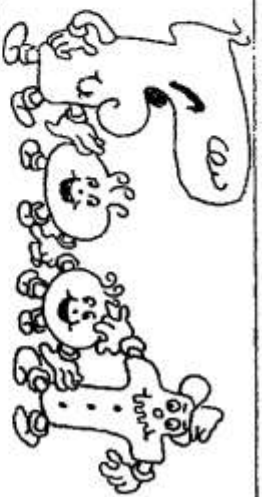
Our memory sentence is- "Every day holds Joy abounding." Our word to remember this week is Joy.

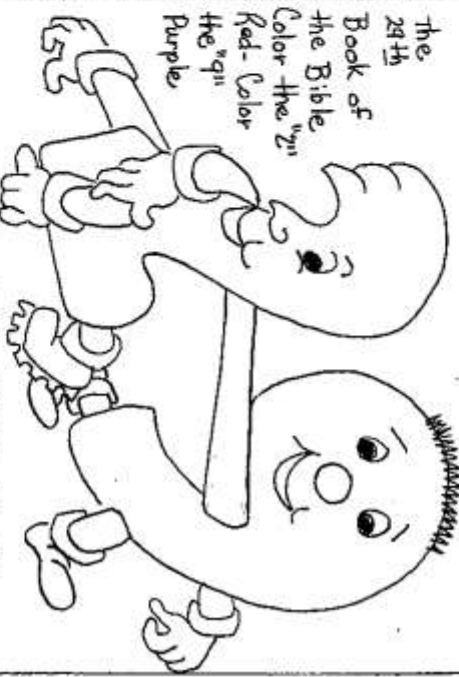

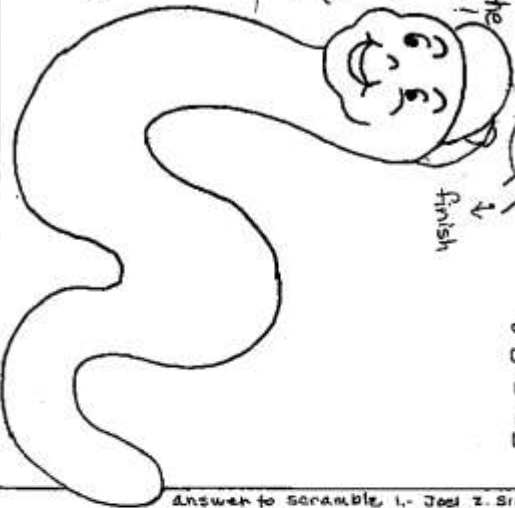

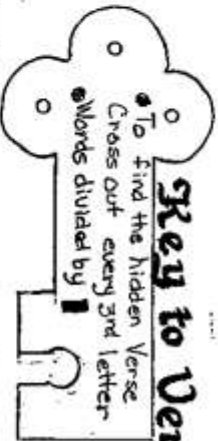
