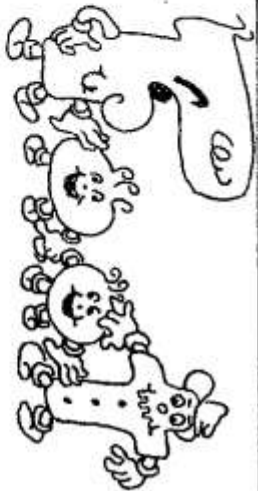
Our memory sentence is - "Enjoy songs imparting Jesus' Love," Our word to remember this week is Love.

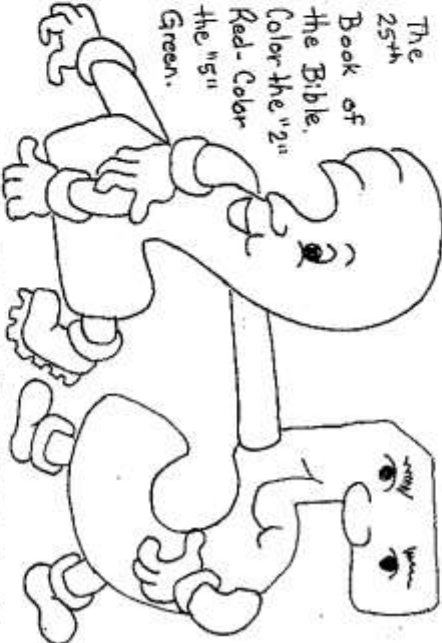

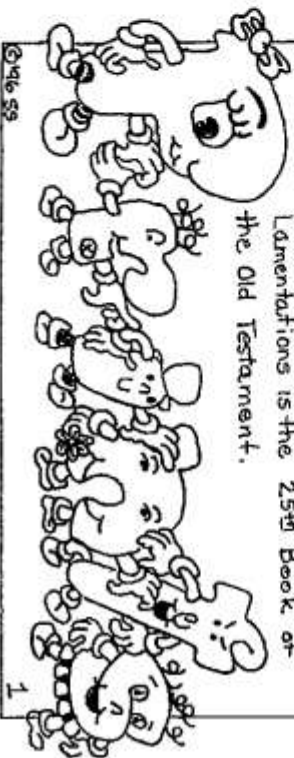

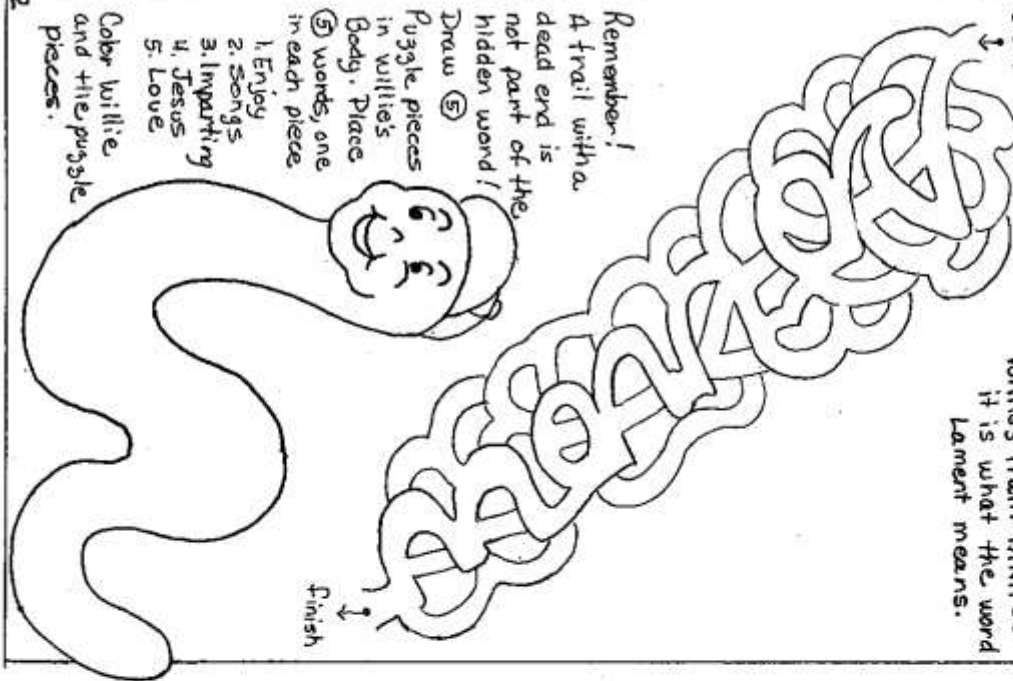
The 25th Book of the Bible. Color the "2" Red-Color the "5" Green.
