


Welcome to Kelletown Baptist Church!

By Statement:

For one who has been saved and baptized by immersion after being saved, but is not a member of another Southern Baptist Church.

We will meet again this week at 5:15 in the Families of Faith classroom.



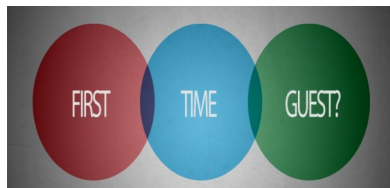
