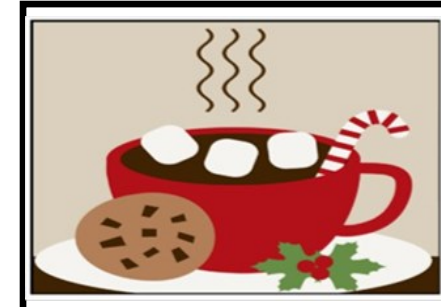
Christmas Eve Candlelight Service

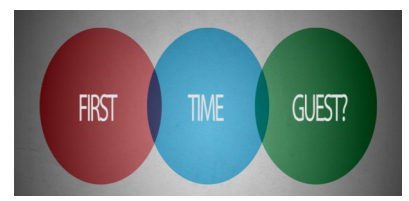
Xtreme Winter
