We invite you to come to the front to speak with a minister about your decision during the Invitation.

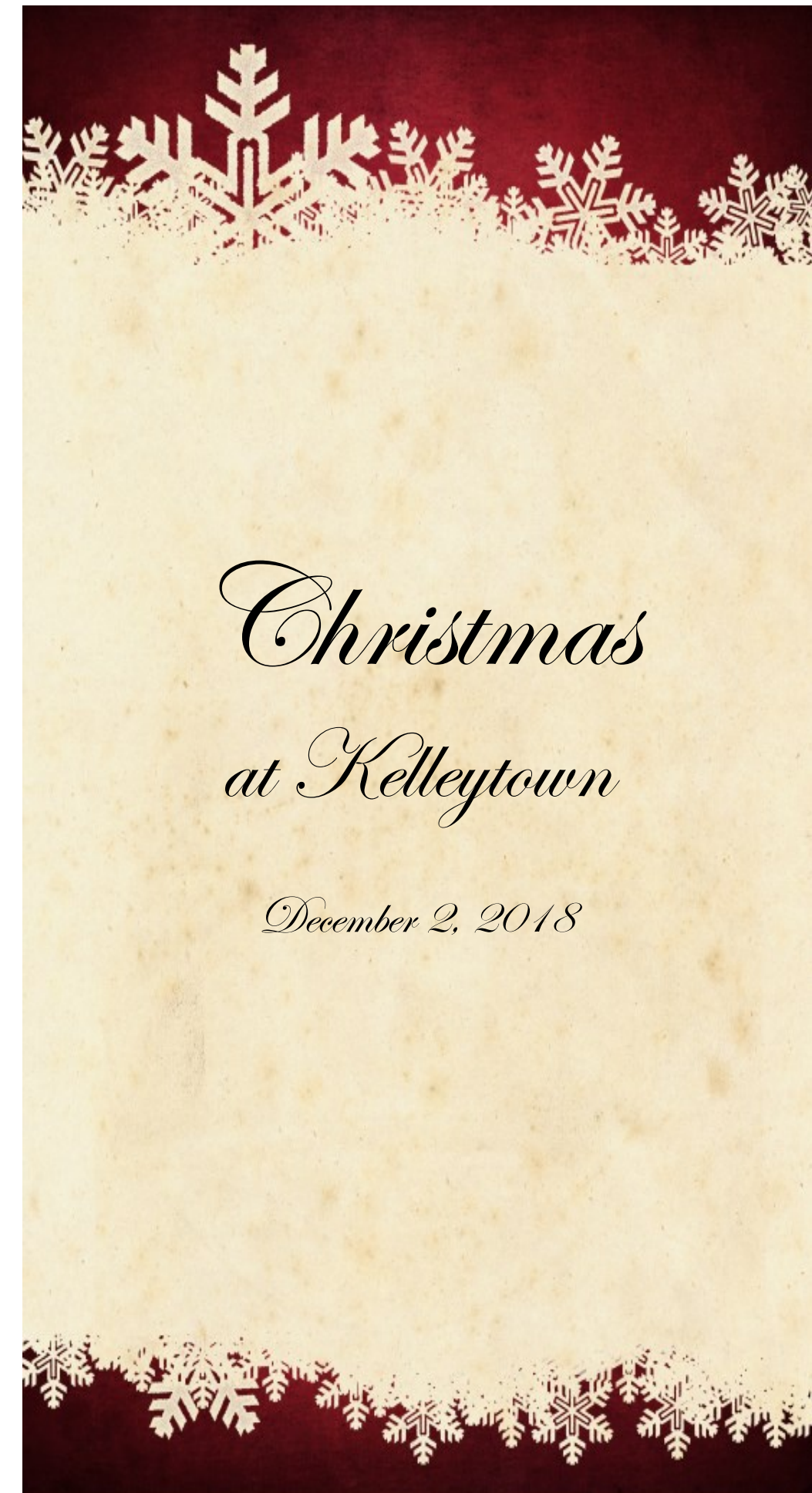
How To Become A Christian
