


Welcome to Kelleytown Baptist Church!

How To Become A Christian

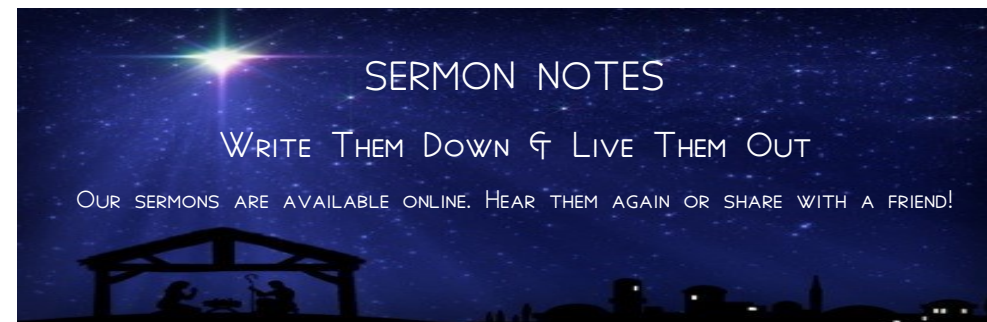
Admit to Jesus that you have sinned. *"All have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God"* (Romans 3:23).

Confess to Jesus that you need Him as your Savior. *"Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved"* (Romans 10:13).

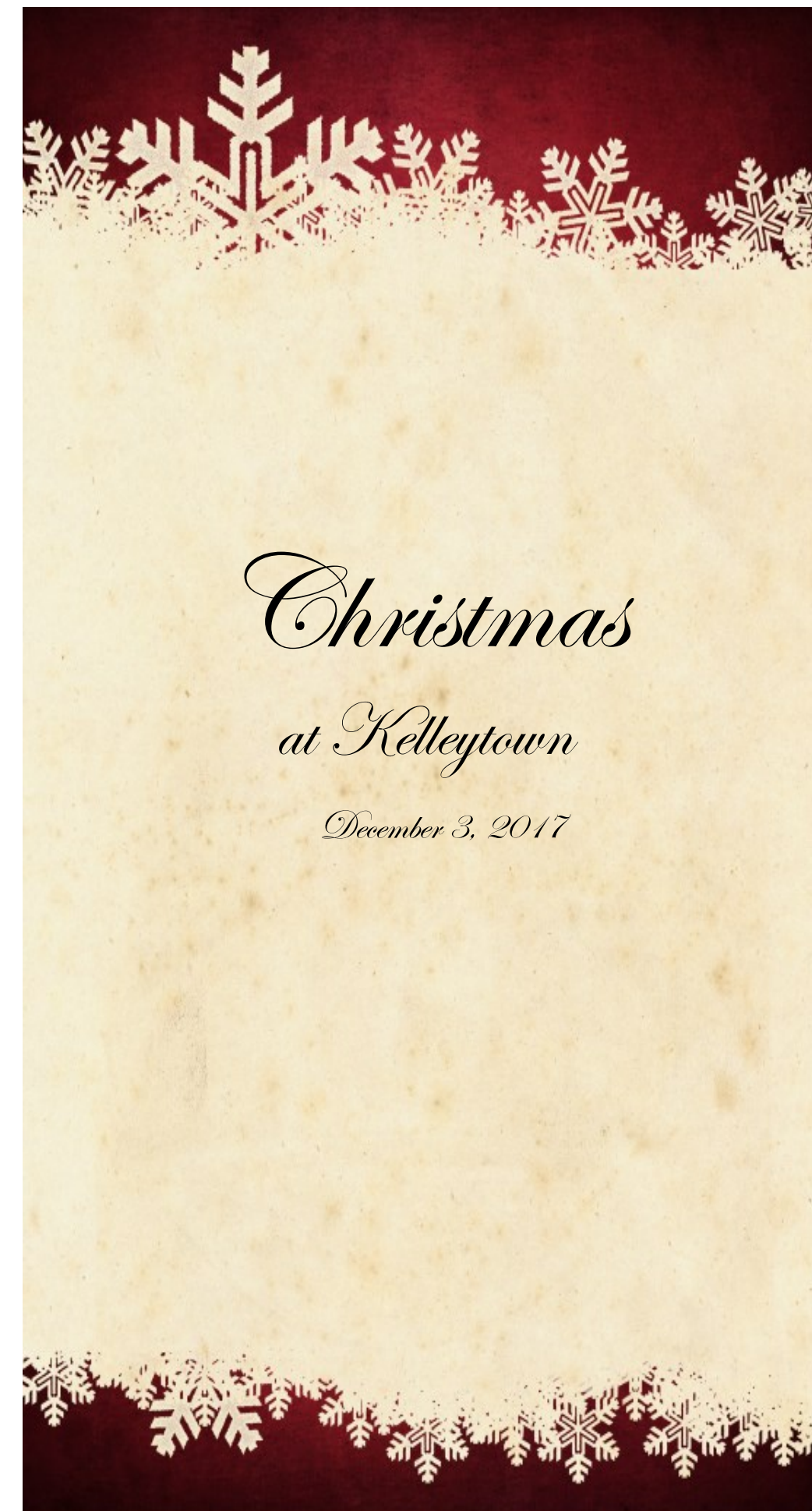

Carolina Kids: Our next monthly mission project for Carolina Kids is this Wednesday, December 6th.

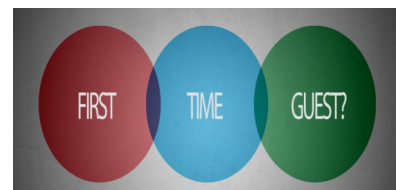
