We are going back to Summer Salt! July 1st-5th. We are so excited for camp this year. Sign up starts in February with a \$50 deposit.

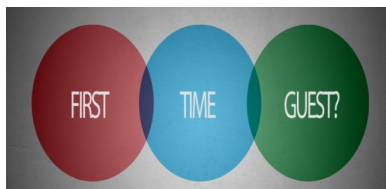
