


## Welcome to Kelletown Baptist Church!

**Confess** to Jesus that you need Him as your Savior. *"Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved"* (Romans 10:13).

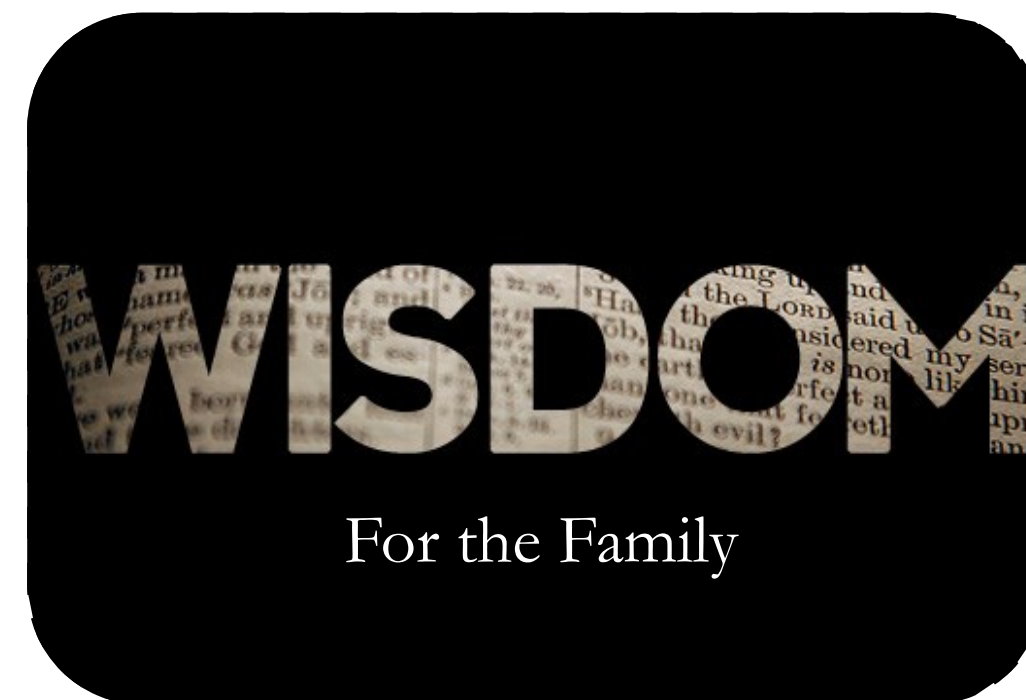

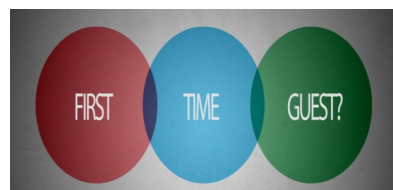
