March 15th the students will be going to Winter Jam! Tickets are \$20 and students need to bring food money but if they bring a friend admission is FREE!

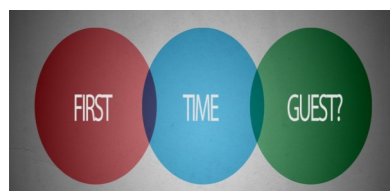
**Summer Camp**
