


## Welcome to Kelletown Baptist Church!

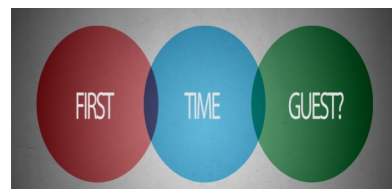
