


Welcome to Kelleytown Baptist Church!

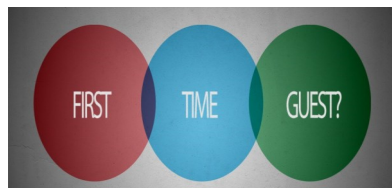
