- Cost: The estimate is \$1,500. However, we do some financing that can help with a portion of the cost.
- When: We are scheduled for July 9-17. Because of Summer School and Sheffey Camp Meeting we are seeking to change the dates to July 23-31.
- Who can go? Anyone who loves God and is willing to serve. This is a joint ministry of the Holston United Methodists in Giles County.
