

KBA Covid-19 Guidelines

- *By coming to the campground at Kiamichi Baptist Assembly every group agrees to abide by the Camp Guidelines, additional Covid 19 Guidelines, and any schedule/special rules in place for the summer of 2020.
- *Provide parents and guardians with information regarding the exposure risks associated with Covid-19.
- *Bring to camp signed camper health forms and special Covid-19 forms, group registration forms, and verification of background check form.
- * Provide notice to all parents and guardians of the enhanced risks of campers being in direct contact with anyone age 65 or older (or individual with a compromised health condition) for 14 days after the end of the camp session.
- * Provide notice to parent or guardian that any camper that becomes symptomatic of Covid-19 or is shown to have a temperature, must be picked up from camp within 8 hours.
- * Any positive test of Covid-19 among sponsors or campers will be reported to any group that may have come in contact with the individual.
- * If 3 or more sponsors or campers test positive for Covid-19, work with state or local authorities about continued operation of camp for the immediate future.
- * Campers and sponsors should act consistent with all US State Department travel restrictions for international travel.
- * No parents or guardians visiting the camp during or between camp sessions, except to drop-off and pick-up campers. No visitors to the camp.
- * Implement increased daily sanitization protocols for common surfaces, restrooms, dining halls, and dorms. Make hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, soap and water, or similar disinfectant readily available.
- * Before leaving to come to camp, groups should screen individuals for any symptoms of Covid-19, including temperature taken. It would be a good policy to have/bring a forehead thermometer for your group.
- * Campers should sleep head-to-toe in upper and lower bunks and spaced as far apart as feasible in the cabin.
- * Limit trips outside camp for supplies by sponsors when at all possible, with facemasks recommended. No excursions away from camp with campers and then returning. Any camper that leaves the campground, other than needed first aid treatment, cannot return to the camp.
- * Groups will deep clean and sanitize cabins and staff will deep clean and sanitize camp common areas at the end of each camp session.
- * Any person who has current Covid-19 test results pending cannot attend camp.
