Here are a couple of things to know about this new trailer.

Here is a list of things included on the trailer. A popcorn popper with all the stuff needed to make popcorn. A snow cone machine with juice (you provide your own ice), footballs and a sports throw, a cotton candy machine with stuff, a basketball goal and basketballs, extension cords and a generator, 4 power strips, an ice chest and cooler, outdoor light (4), a corn hole game, tic tac toe bean bag game, kick balls, soccer balls & cones for soccer, Frisbee game with 6 frisbees, horse shoe games both indoor and outdoor, lawn darts/bocca safe game, a sound system with mic, speakers, cords, a jenga game and tools and safety equipment.

This is a \$20,000 trailer given to us through the BGCO because of your faithful giving to us through our State missions offering. Why through this offering? This is an Evangelistic trailer and is to be used only for evangelistic events (sorry it can't be used for graduation parties or birthday parties unless you present the gospel). This trailer is to be used to help share the gospel of Jesus Christ in our area.

Some of the things you will need to provide will be gospel tracts, toys if you want to give away for the games you play, and an evangelistic heart.

You will be asked to provide a \$25 fee to use the trailer. This is to help replenish the popcorn, snow cone juice, sugar for cotton candy and to help do repairs, replacements or buy new things that you might see that we could use for this trailer.

We are asking you to also do a couple of things:

Fill out an EBPT form after you use it and return it to the office with a clean trailer. This form will help us to see the evangelistic progress for our association. It will also give us an idea on what you would like to see added to the trailer.

We would also like for you to make of list of things that need repairing after your use.

We would ask that you clean the machines with the proper cleaning materials that are provided with the trailer so the next group will have a clean trailer.

Dates are being claimed this summer for usage. Things like VBS, back to school events, etc. We want to encourage all churches to use this tool as we reach people for Christ in our area. Just call the office to schedule a date for your church.
